






Create to start Stocktake


Only Managers should create.

Click on ADD A LINE








Inventory Reference: The Month and year of the Stock take (E.g., January 2021)

- Stock take: The name of the stock take (E.g., Monthly)
- Inventoried Location: There will be an auto filled location here

- Company: Should be only your practice (E.g., Spectacle Warehouse



Start Inventory – Starting the Stocktake





After clicking on Start Inventory, you will be greeted by the following screen.



Click on Load All Products (This will then load all of the products for that location underneath the all product tab)

From here, just start scanning and the Real Qty will update.





Do not press add a line to add stock, only start scanning





If the Product is scanned correctly, a loading icon will appear briefly in the right bottom corner to indicate that the item has been scanned.

On this list, you will see all of the scanned items.


Theoretical Quantity is the amount that is currently in stock

Real Quantity is the amount that has been currently scanned.

 Click on RUN COMPARISON to remove the products that has been scanned out of the ALL PRODUCTS tab. Thus after doing a final comparison run, the items left in the ALL PRODUCTS tab, are the items not scanned.

If a barcode is not picking up, wait until the loading has stopped and then add a line and put it in the barcode. (This should happen just before validation)

If there is more than 1 of the same items you wish to scan, you don't have to scan them all. You will click on the item and update the quantity to the total quantity you wish to capture.





On this list, you will see all of the scanned items

We would recommend keeping the ones aside that doesn't want to scan until you are finished scanning everything,

Then you can search for the barcode by using CTRL + F and type in the barcode you are looking for.

Thereafter adjust the quantity; if the barcode is not already scanned, then add a line, type in the barcode, and save.

Remember to save as frequently as possible to avoid loss of data.



Never ever press the VALIDATE INVENTORY OR CANCEL INVENTORY, as this validates the entire inventory, and you'll need to start at the beginning.

On this screen in the top right corner, you will find:




- o Details Where the Stocktake will be shown in more detail
- Barcode The view will only show the barcodes that have been scanned, and you can scan barcodes here to see more data. (Enterprise only)

This is what the details screen looks like:




When in the details screen, you will be able to add the following filters



- Missing Stock: Shows a list of all the stock that the theoretical quantity is more than the real Quantity
- Over Stock: Shows a list of all the stock that the theoretical Quantity is less than the real Quantity.
- Matching Stock: Shows a list of all the stock that the Theoretical Quantity matches with the Real Quantity
- Stock with differences: Show a list of all the stock that the theoretical Quantity and real Quantity that has any differences.




This is what the barcode screen looks like (Enterprise Only)



Yet again, do not press VALIDATE

The Products in Inventory Details are all that have been scanned, if the line Is blue, the theoretical Quantity and real Quantity don't match. Then you will need to go see why it doesn't match (maybe miss scanned or missing from the store)



If the products are black, it means that the quantity does match up and that there are no missed items

When Stocktake is finished, and all of the products have been loaded, you can click on validate.

Note: Pressing the VALIDATE INVENTORY button will change the Theoretical qty (Stock on hand on the system) to the REAL QTY (The total units scanned in on this Stocktake)

Reporting can be checked under the inventory module.
